emphasis from indoctrination to inquiry and scholarship though he was dismissed for his policies in 1863 tappan s efforts to establish a broad and liberal curriculum prevailed michigan was to take its place among the leading educational institutions in this country and to achieve an international reputation as a research center several past philosophers are worthy of mention here george sylvester morris an absolute idealist joined the department in 1881 having served from 1870 as chairman of the department of modern languages and literature he assumed the chairmanship of philosophy in 1884
